Subject pronouns stand in for the person doing the action, and they go in front of the verb: she runs, they laughed. English has a separate set for this job, which is why "her runs" sounds wrong even though it is perfectly understandable.

What to expect: Children often use their own name before they use "I" ("Mia do it"), and mixing up he and she is extremely common well into the fourth year - often long after the child clearly knows the difference between boys and girls. Gender is not the hard part; retrieving the right little word fast enough is.
