Back of the tongue up for /g/, release, and the tongue tip springs forward to the ridge for /l/.

SOUND

/gl/

TYPICAL AGE

By age 5

TYPE

Voiced Stop + liquid cluster

PRACTICE TIP

GL and CL are the same motion with the voice off or on - drill them together for good contrast practice.

GL does not occur often in the middle or at the end of English words, so this page practices it at the beginning.

Initial Position (16 words)

The sound is at the beginning of the word.

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Generalization

Play-based ideas for young children

Glove hunt

Match pairs of gloves and mittens.

Words that come up: glove, gloves, glad, glass, glow, pair, match, more, again, on, off, hands, cold, warm

Glow in the dark

Use glow sticks or glow stars in a dark room.

Words that come up: glow, glowing, glass, glad, glide, dark, light, look, again, more, bright, on, off, wow
