

GR Blend Word List

Release the back-of-mouth /g/ directly into the bunched R. Both sounds are voiced, so the hum never stops.

SOUND

/gr/

TYPICAL AGE

By age 5-7

TYPE

Voiced Stop + liquid cluster

PRACTICE TIP

GR, like CR, keeps the tongue in the back of the mouth - often the easiest place to find a first clean R blend.

GR does not occur often in the middle or at the end of English words, so this page practices it at the beginning.

High-frequency initial words

Everyday words rather than picture-card words - which is why most lists leave them out. A child already says these hundreds of times a day, so they carry more carryover value than any noun above. Target them in conversation, not in drill.

great, grandma, grandpa, growing, grows

Generalization

Word lists get a sound into a child's mouth. Generalization is what gets it into their life. These are activities where the target words come up on their own, so nobody has to be talked into practicing.

Play-based ideas for young children

Grape snack

Eat grapes and count them. Grab, grip, grin.

Words that come up: grape, grab, green, grin, great, more, please, eat, yum, again, big, small, all gone, my turn

Grass and garden

Play outside or with a toy garden. Grow seeds, cut grass.

Words that come up: grass, grow, green, ground, garden, grab, more, again, dig, water, big, look, dirt, plant

Grandma phone call

Pretend to call grandma and grandpa on a toy phone.

Words that come up: grandma, grandpa, great, green, grab, hello, bye, again, more, talk, love, miss, call, hi
